Instructions:

- Qualifying students must reside in the geographic area of the ASCE Dothan Branch. This area includes Barbour, Coffee, Dale, Geneva, Henry, Houston, and Pike Counties. Any high school/GED graduate may apply, but significant preference will be granted to students who have completed one year of college credit and are enrolled in the school of engineering in the civil or pre-civil curriculum in an ABET accredited engineering program.
- Transcript copy: Furnish, with the application, one copy of final High School transcript, or, current transcript showing one year of full-time college credit, and proof of enrollment in the Civil or pre-Civil curriculum in an ABET accredited school. Non-certified transcripts printed for student record are acceptable. For applicants completing high school or their Freshman year too late for availability of a final or current transcript to meet the May 15 deadline, verifiable evidence of current high school standing, or one-year, full-time enrollment in the pre-civil or civil curriculum, and course work grade average must be provided. This may be the current transcript up to the most recently completed semester along with a copy of website posting of final grades for the second semester, or a signed letter from a student counselor/advisor attesting current standing.
- Application: Complete entire form. If additional space is required for any item, continue on a separate sheet and attach to
 application. If there are any other accomplishments which may be of value in selecting a recipient other than the items
 listed below, please list them on a separate sheet attached to this form. Applications may be obtained in Microsoft Word
 format for ease of editing from contact below.

Scholarship amount/s will range from \$1,000 to \$2,500 depending on funds available, decisions of the selection committee made up of the local ASCE Dothan Branch Officers and past Officers, and the number of scholarships awarded.

The ASCE Dothan Branch Selection Committee will evaluate each application and choose the applicant or applicants the Committee deems is/are most deserving. The recipient/s will be chosen based on a combination of various traits such as academic achievements, community involvement, need, essay, etc. "The Branch desires the presence of the scholarship recipient at the ASCE Branch meeting, at noon, on June 12, 2019 at the Rotary Hall of the Wiregrass Rehab Center in Dothan, AL for presentation of scholarship."
